

DESERT PRINCESS COUNTRY CLUB MEN'S GOLF TOURNAMENT DESCRIPTIONS

ECLECTIC

This is an individual two-day stroke play event in which a player's best score on each hole will be used to determine his 18-hole score for the tournament. The number of flights will be determined by the total number of participants. Players may choose whether they want to play from the BLUE tees or the WHITE tees. Prizes will be awarded for both gross and net scores within your flight.

TWO MAN SCRAMBLE

This is a one-day 18-hole stroke play event in which the scramble format will be utilized. Players may select their own partners with a maximum handicap differential of twelve (12) strokes. Players may choose whether they want to play from the BLUE tees or the WHITE tees. (A certain number of tee shots may be required for each player.) Prizes will be awarded for both gross and net scores.

MEMBER/MEMBER

This is a two-day stroke play event in which two-man teams use the best ball format. Players may select their own partners with a maximum handicap differential of ten (10) strokes. Players may choose whether they want to play from the BLUE tees or the WHITE tees. Although a team with one or both participants playing from the WHITE tees may win the tournament, only the team with both participants playing from the BLUE tees is eligible to move on to play in an SCGA event. Prizes will be awarded for both gross and net scores, but the Net Winner, as clarified above, is the team eligible to move on to play in an SCGA event.

CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP

This is an individual three-day 54-hole stroke play event. The field will be divided into flights. The Club Champion will be the person with the lowest aggregate gross score from the "Championship Flight" which will be playing from the GOLD Tees. Any player can join the "Championship Flight" to be eligible to win the Club Championship. The "President's Flight" will be playing from the BLUE Tees and "Vice President's" flight will be playing from the WHITE tees. Players may select the tees from where they prefer to play. The number of flights will be determined by the number of entries. All flights, in addition to the Club Champion award, will have gross and net prizes, except for the Vice President's flight which will only have net prizes.

CACTUS CLASSIC (MEMBER/GUEST)

This event is open to all Country Club Members who have a full golf membership. There will be two-man teams consisting of the golf member and his invited guest. The formats played, numbers of holes played, and additional competitive events will be determined by the Cactus Classic Tournament Committee.

PINEHURST

This is one-day 18-hole stroke play event consisting of two-man teams. Players may select their own partners with a maximum handicap differential of twelve (12) strokes. The format is both players tee off, hit each other's ball on the second shot, and then pick the best position and alternate shots with one ball until the ball is holed out. Players may choose whether they want to play from the BLUE tees or the WHITE tees. Prizes will be awarded for both gross and net scores.

TOURNAMENT OF CHAMPIONS

To qualify to play in this one-day 18-hole stroke play event, a player must have won another tournament, or a flight within a tournament, during the previous year. There will only be one flight, but players may choose whether they want to play from the BLUE tees or the WHITE tees. Prizes will be awarded for both gross and net scores.

SHAMBLE

This is a one-day 18-hole stroke play event consisting of four-man teams. Based on handicap, the Golf Shop staff will make up teams so that each team has an A, B, C and D player. A and B players will play from the BLUE tees and C and D players will play from the WHITE tees. The format is all players tee off from their respective tees, the team selects the best shot and then each player plays his own ball from that position until the ball is holed out. (A certain number of tee shots may be required for each player.) The team score on each hole is the total of one (1) gross score and two (2) net scores. (If participation warrants that there should be three-man teams, then the team score on each hole will be the total of one (1) gross score and one (1) net score.)

TWO MAN BEST BALL/SCRAMBLE

This is a one-day 18-hole stroke play event in which the best ball format will be utilized for nine (9) holes and the scramble format will be utilized for nine (9) holes. Players may select their own partners with a maximum handicap differential of twelve (12) strokes. Players may choose whether they want to play from the BLUE tees or the WHITE tees. (A certain number of tee shots may be required for each player for the nine (9) holes in which the scramble format is being played.) Prizes will be awarded for both gross and net scores.

ONE MAN SCRAMBLE

This is an individual one-day 18-hole stroke play event. Two (2) times on each hole a player may use the scramble format. When using the scramble format, the player must remain in the same playing condition, and cannot use the scramble format more than once on any shot. Players may choose whether they want to play from the BLUE tees or the WHITE tees. Prizes will be awarded for both gross and net scores.

BEAT THE PRO

This is an individual one-day 18-hole stroke play event. Players' net scores from the front nine (9), back nine (9), and total eighteen (18) holes will be compared to the professional's gross scores for the front, back, and total. Players may choose whether they want to play from the BLUE tees or the WHITE tees. All players who beat (NOT TIE) the professional in any of these comparisons will share in one or more of the three (3) prize funds (front, back, and total) in which they beat the professional.

TEE IT FORWARD

This is an individual one-day 18-hole stroke play event in which all players play from the forward tees. Prizes will be awarded for both gross and net scores.
